Terms and Conditions

- ◆ Applicant must meet all the terms, conditions, and eligibility requirement for the rebate program.
- ◆ The rebate does not apply to sales tax, seat, fittings, or installation charges.
- ◆ Applicant must provide original sales receipts and invoices as proof of purchase. Receipts and invoices must clearly state price of fixture eligible for rebate, less tax. Receipts and invoices must clearly state manufacturer and model numbers. Receipts and invoices must reflect the date of purchase. Original receipts will be returned, upon request.
- ◆ An on-site inspection by a representative of the District may be required to verify installation before a rebate is approved and paid. A representative of the District must be allowed to inspect the property to verify fixture model and installation.
- ◆ The property and fixtures must be served by the District and have an active water account.
- ◆ If the applicant is going to install more than four fixtures, it is required that the applicant call the District to get pre-approval. Pre-approval may require an inspection.
- ◆ Permits may be required for the replacement of fixtures. Check with your local building authority to inquire about permitting.
- ◆ New construction is only eligible, if the fixtures installed are more efficient that current building standards or standards required for the building permit.
- ◆ Both the fixture and the valve must meet the following high efficiency standards:
 - Urinals: maximum of 0.5 gallons per flush from qualifying list provided by the District or EPA WaterSense labeled.
 - Flushometer Valve Toilets: Maximum of 1.28 gallons per flush from qualifying list provided by the District.
 - Tank Toilets: Maximum of 1.28 gallons per flush or dual flush from the qualifying list provided by the District or EPA WaterSense labeled.
- ◆ Applicants are encouraged to recycle their toilets and urinals. Contact Recycle Works San Mateo County <http://www.recycleworks.org/> or RecycleWorks Hotline: 1-888-442-2666
- ◆ Rebate amounts are up to:
 - High Efficiency Urinals: \$300
 - High Efficiency Flush Valve Toilets: \$300
 - High Efficiency Tank Toilets: \$100If the purchase price is less than the maximum rebate amount, the purchase price becomes the rebate amount.
- ◆ The effective date of the rebate offer is July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. Fixtures must be purchased and installed during this period to be eligible.

This rebate program is designed to provide financial assistance to customers wishing to replace higher water using fixtures with water conserving fixtures. Installation of the fixture is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is the determination of the adequacy and compatibility of their existing plumbing system. The District assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property, as a result of participation in the program. Due to circumstances and factors beyond the control of the District, it cannot guarantee that installation of water conserving fixtures will result in lower utility costs.
