

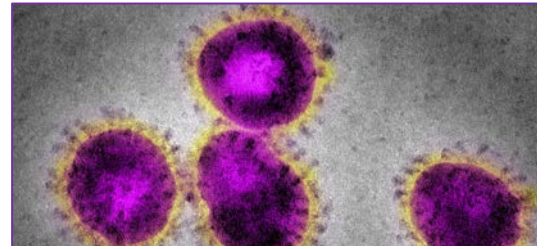
COVID-19: Is my drinking water safe?

Yes, the water you receive from Coastside County Water District has been treated and disinfected and is safe to drink.

The District's two treatment plants treat all the water delivered to the District's customers and chlorine is used to disinfect the water, as it travels through the distribution system and is delivered to customers.

According to public health experts, person-to-person contact is the main method for the spread of the coronavirus. Symptoms experienced by people infected with COVID-19 are difficulty breathing, cough and fever.

District staff encourage customers to talk with their health care providers, if they feel they are at risk of becoming infected with COVID-19 or are experiencing symptoms associated with COVID-19.
